# Increasing Moderate to Vigorous Physical Activity (MVPA) in Young Children

**Early childhood educators can help young children increase their MVPA by:**

◆ **Arranging the environment to allow for movement**

Do you have room indoors for children to dance, play follow the leader or twirl hoops around various parts of their body? Does the outdoor space include areas for running jumping, climbing, and building obstacle courses?

◆ **Buying equipment and props with movement in mind**

Choose items like scarves, ribbon sticks, plastic hoops, jump ropes in a variety of shapes, sizes and textures. Purchase equipment so all children have access.



◆ **Demonstrating enthusiasm for physical activity**

Children learn by watching important adults in their lives. Did you know that studies have shown the amount of children's physical activity during "movement time" is directly related to how active the teacher is, so get up and move. Be a role model.

◆ **Helping children understand why movement is important**

Help children recognize that when they are moving something is happening to their heart. Ask children to feel their heart beating, after an activity like running or jumping. You can ask, "Is your heart going faster?" You can teach children that this means your heart is saying, "thank you, thank you."

## Professional Information - False Allegations and Provider Vulnerability

---

While taking care of children may be your primary occupation, taking care of your image and how others perceive what you do is also of concern.

Providers may unexpectedly find themselves facing an accusation by a parent, a neighbor, or even a total stranger. Accusations can range from claims of inadequate supervision, inappropriate or harmful behavior by family members, or disregard for safety measures, to actual physical or sexual abuse by the provider.

When it happens, providers are typically unprepared for the effects it has on themselves, their business and their family. At the very least, there is the discomfort of explaining to a sympathetic and understanding licenser your version of the circumstances. At the other extreme, a provider may face the prospect of months of interrogation by numerous investigators and even having their business closed down. Providers often believe it could never happen to them, but even the most conscientious provider can find themselves faced with an allegation of abuse or neglect.

While you can't totally prevent the possibility of becoming the victim of a false allegation, there are some things you do to minimize the potential risk.

**Become knowledgeable** about child abuse and reporting laws, licensing regulations, child development and positive guidance techniques, including cultural differences.

**Follow licensing regulations** especially those involving supervision and child guidance. Do not operate over your license capacity and make sure any variance from regulations is officially approved in writing beforehand.

**Practice safety and accident prevention.** Supervise children at all times. Check on children frequently, even during naptime. Keep play areas and rooms open and visible for easy supervision. Conduct daily safety checks. Be sure hazardous materials are put away and safety guidelines are followed.

### **Develop and Implement Policies**

- Carefully screen all helpers and substitutes. Make sure they understand all rules and regulations. Supervise and train all staff, helpers and volunteers about regulations, policies and child development.

## Reminders About Training Attendance

**T**hank you for your diligence as a child care professional and for your dedication in your on-going training and development.

When attending PATCH training classes there are a few guidelines to remember:

**Sign Up for Classes Ahead of Time:** Please remember to sign up for PATCH classes ahead of time, by calling your local PATCH office. This helps us to monitor attendance, especially when a class requires minimum enrollment. It also gives us time to prepare materials for classes.

**Remember to sign in:** Please remember to sign in. You will not receive a certificate for a training class if your name does not appear on the sign-in sheet. Please check all information on the sign-in sheet. Print clearly when correcting any errors in your name, address, or telephone number.

**Be on time:** If you arrive more than 15 minutes late, you will not be allowed to sign in. If you are unable to stay for the full duration of the training, you will not receive a training certificate. In both circumstances, your attendance will not be posted in the PATCH database for that class.

Likewise, if a trainer is more than 15 minutes late – you may assume that the class has been cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances. We will call you to reschedule the class.

**Turn off your cell phone:** As a courtesy to other participants, please turn off the volume of your cell phone or pager.

**Adults only please:** We love children, but as a courtesy to other participants, we ask that you make alternative arrangements for child care.

**Bring your Record of Training:** Please bring your Record of Training (available via the PATCH office) with you to each class and

remember to get the instructor's signature after each class. When you have completed an entire series, return the original Record of Training to the PATCH office and we will mail you a Certificate of Completion for the series.

**Keep good records:** Whether you take a PATCH class or any other training, you should keep track of the trainings you attend for future reference. If you need verification of your PATCH classes, there is a \$2.00 fee for a computer printout list of classes taken at PATCH. If you have misplaced your Record of Training sheet, there is a \$3.00 fee for a replacement. Duplicate certificates are available for \$1.00 each. Please keep in mind that PATCH often deletes information beyond 5 years to make room for the next year.

**Basic Series (10 classes)** - *An overview of basic skills to become a successful family child care provider.*

**Challenging Behaviors Basic Series (7 classes)** - *This series is for experienced caregivers looking to gain in-depth knowledge and strategies for working with children (ages 2-8) who have challenging behaviors.*

*New!*

**Quality Care Series (10 classes)** - *The workshops in this new series are designed to support staff in early childhood programs as they engage in the self-assessment process for the Hawaii Preschool Content Standards incentive of the Quality Care Program. Also meets professional development for early educators.*

**Puppet Series (5 classes)** - *For all early childhood professionals who are interested in using puppets to build literacy skills.*

**Supporting Play Series (5 classes)** - *Looks at methods early childhood professionals can utilize to help children (3-5 yrs.) develop socially and cognitively through play.*

**WestEd Basic Infant/Toddler Series (10 classes)** - *Introductory series to working with children age 0-3 yrs. (meets I/T licensing requirements).*

**WestEd Advanced Infant/Toddler Series (10 classes)** - *Focuses on additional considerations when working with children 0-3 yrs. (meets I/T licensing requirements).*

**Introduction to Preschool Series (7 classes)** - *This series is for new preschool staff and will provide an overview of working with preschool-aged children in centers or homes.*

**Infant/Toddler Series 3 (10 classes)** - *This series will continue to build on the foundations laid in the West Ed Basic and Advanced series for Infant and Toddlers. Meets DHS requirements for the 15 hours of maintaining Infant/Toddler professional development training.*

There are **8 Subject Areas** utilized for the Child Development Associate (CDA). These indicators are important when looking for specific types of classes to fulfill initial CDA requirements :

- Never use or agree to use corporal punishment, even if requested by the parent.
- Develop and implement written policies concerning discipline, toileting/diaper changing, napping routine, touch and suspected child abuse reporting, etc.

**Document and keep records** about children, unusual behaviors, parent communication, accidents and any conflicts with parents or staff

- Document and report unusual behaviors, injuries, or problems with parents to your licenser. Keep a file of your concerns.
- Document any serious conflicts with parents.
- When problems arise, clearly and objectively communicate to parents what happened, what you did about it, and why.
- Document behavior problems with children, and any consequences you need.
- Document accidents and incidents which happen between children or between adults and children; have witnesses sign the documentation.
- Keep copies of any written communication with parents or staff/helpers.

**Maintain open and daily communication** with parents to avoid misunderstandings or misinterpretations.



Documentation is a valuable asset when problems arise. You may wish to create a file for each child and keep copies of all written communications or information on the child in the file.

Another idea is to keep a daily log or notebook. Include information about activities, children's behaviors and physical changes, communication with parents, calls to and from you licensing worker, etc. The log provides an ongoing documentation record that can be helpful should an allegation arise.

Unfortunately, there is no way to guarantee that an allegation of maltreatment or neglect won't be made against you, even if you follow all precautions. It is, therefore, important to understand your rights and how the "system" works.

What happens when you are the subject of an investigation?

**The Investigative Process** The rules of the Child Protection and resulting Licensing action process are different from criminal or civil proceedings. Each system has its own procedure.

Several government agencies are mandated by law to protect the safety and health of children in child care settings. The agencies most frequently involved are Child Protection, Law Enforcement and Licensing. Each has an area of responsibility and accountability.

Licensing is responsible to make sure basic health and safety standards are

met in all licensed child care facilities and investigating alleged reports of child maltreatment/abuse in licensed child care facilities. Law enforcement is responsible for enforcing laws and filing charges against individuals who break those laws.
