

On March 17, 2023, Perrigo Company plc issued a voluntary nationwide recall of certain lots of Gerber® Good Start® SootheProTM manufactured infant formula. This product, sold at retailers across the U.S., is being recalled out of an abundance of caution due to the potential presence of Cronobacter sakazakii. No illnesses have been reported and no other products manufactured at this facility or any other of the Company's facilities are affected by this recall.
